- Our annual conference is IAFCC's opportunity to support our members and show our appreciation for the dedicated health care they provide to the uninsured and underinsured in Illinois.



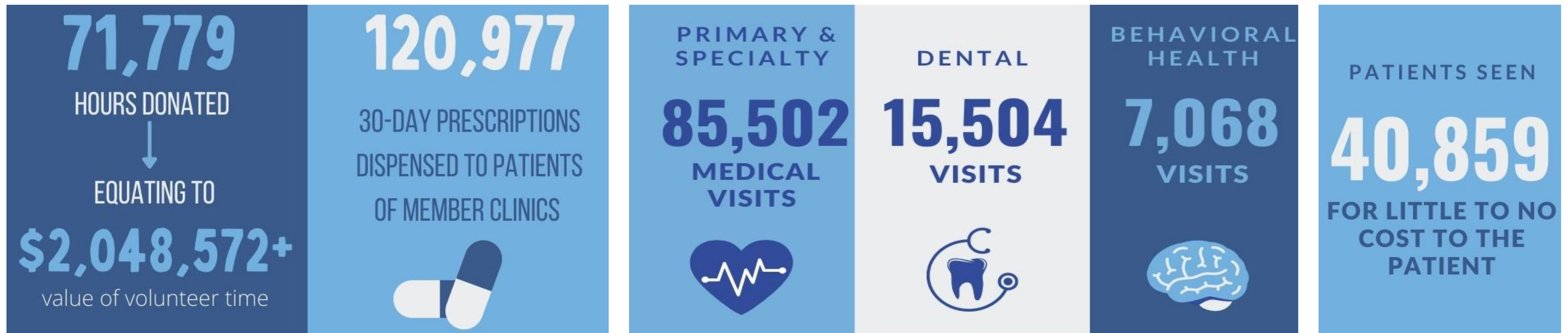
WHAT IS THE CONFERENCE
